This is Shirley Schneider. In 1972, she took on the challenge of building a school within Balfour High School where these young students could continue their education. It was called the Special Tutorial Class. Today, it's called the Shirley Schneider Support Centre (SSSC), and now, several thousand students have crossed through the doors.



Once the school was established, Shirley worked tirelessly to build a safe place for the SSSC students to take their kids for care.

Opening its doors in 1986, the Mackenzie Infant Care Centre is right across the street from SSSC. The moms can go to school, knowing that their little one is close and being cared for by trained caregivers.

MICC is nestled into a character home on College Avenue, with three more sites located in the lower level of Balfour. There's a big family that lives there when school is in session - 51 in total: 36 infants and 15 toddlers! Of course, there is an amazing group of caregivers working together to provide a healthy start for these children. Imagine caring for that many tiny humans, every day.

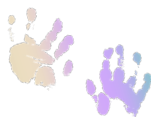
MICC goes through supplies in bulk, including diapers, formula, food, books, toys, strollers, car seats and more. If you have kids then you know how long this list can be! 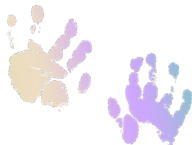
(\$2,000) Lunch For the Mamas

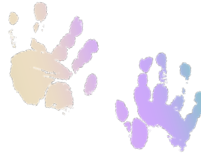
(\$750) Go for a Stroll

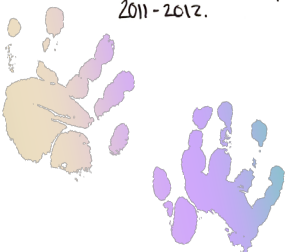
